The wine program at black & blue has been designed to make the most of your experience by providing the best value in an array of styles, brands and price, so don't worry if you are unfamiliar with many of the producers. That said, we also wanted to incorporate many big names and known producers as well as up and coming regions and the latest wine trends, this way you have the opportunity to have your favorite bottle or try something you just read about.

The list itself is categorized by TYPE of wine with Sparkling and White Wines listed in the front and Red Wines listed in the back. The list is then categorized by VARIETAL, or "type" of grape, which is also sorted from LIGHT to FULL-bodied throughout the list. Additionally, in the very front are some featured wines BY-THE-GLASS. We have a wonderful Coravin system that makes it possible to have wines available to try by the glass that usually are only available by the bottle.

To try one of the staff's recommendations, look for wines in the list that have a "b&b favorite" designation in bold. Each of these wines has been hand-selected specifically with approachability in mind and is accompanied by a profile, or description, of the characteristics of the wine itself.

2017 Pascal Jolivet Sancerre, Loire Valley

Classic sauvignon blanc from a benchmark region for “terroir” in France’s Loire Valley. This brilliantly crisp white wine possesses resounding citrus & grassy notes, balanced by a lush midpalate and an almost effervescent mineral finish. This racy expression of the translated namesake “wild white” is a fantastic summer thirst-quencher and a nimble dance partner to all things seafood.

2016 Miraval Rosé de Provence, France

The product of a partnership between Brad Pitt and Angelina Jolie with the Perrin family of Château Beaucastel in Châteauneuf-du-Pape, this rosé’s “celebrity status” isn’t the only thing going for it. Lovely pale pink in color, the wine exhibits aromas of citrus, red fruits, and white flowers. A balanced and elegant palette of crisp fruit gives way to a lingering floral finish with a touch of salinity that would pair well with anything from our Raw Bar, our Lobster Salad, or our Scallops entrée.

2016 Rombauer Chardonnay, Carneros, Napa

Founded in 1980, Napa Valley’s Rombauer Vineyards is a family-owned winery known for its delicious and distinctive wines crafted to bring joy to the table. The winery was established by Koerner and Joan Rombauer, pioneers of Napa Valley’s modern wine movement whose appreciation for The Joy of Wine and the pleasure it brings to family and friends stems from Koerner’s great aunt, Irma Rombauer, author of the internationally-renowned Joy of Cooking. This Chardonnay has aromas of vanilla, melon and mango and on the palate the flavors are echoed along with crème brûlée, butter, and peach.

2013 Boyer-Martenot “Les Tillets” Meursault, France

Chardonnay from Meursault, Cote de Beaune, Cote d’Or, Burgundy, France. Known to offer a magical balance of smoothness and freshness, Meursault’s quality is hard to rival. The village lies in the middle of Côte de Beaune, just south of Volnay. Meursault is said to mean “mouse’s jump” because in the past the plots producing Pinot Noir and those producing Chardonnay were no more than a mouse’s jump from one another. Today the village is almost exclusively Chardonnay. This wine has enticing aromas of lime peel, tropical fruit, crushed rocks, spice and hazelnut. On the palate there is a wonderful balance of brightness and a seductive length with flavors of white peach, pineapple, and citrus.

2016 Paul Hobbs Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, Sonoma

Founded on Paul Hobbs’s pioneering spirit and adventurous pursuit of innovation and discovery, Paul Hobbs Wines is a highly curated selection of superior quality wines. Through sustainable farming, meticulous vineyard management, and minimally invasive winemaking techniques, each wine expresses its vineyard origins with finesse, complexity and authenticity. Paul Hobbs Wines represents exceptional vineyards, appellations and historic sites from around the world.

2012 Caparzo Brunello di Montalcino, Montalcino, Italy

Brunello (also known as Sangiovese), is the namesake of Montalcino, a southern district in the gorgeous and sun-drenched Tuscany, and this prime example displays a deep garnet color with luscious and penetrating aromas of wild berries, chocolate, and leather. The palate is dry, warm, and full-bodied while structured and bright, the finish, is elegant with a soft, smoky flavor which superbly complements our Lamb entrée.

2013 Château de Beaucastel St. Julien, Bordeaux

After the esteemed red wines of Bordeaux, the second most famous and illustrious French red blend is found in the Châteauneuf-du-Pape region of the Southern Rhône Valley. The conditions of the Southern Rhône are often considered less than favorable, as 70mph winds, blistering heat, and stones the size of small pumpkins all add to the harshness of the region. But, just as diamonds are produced under immense pressure, so, too, is great wine. Château de Beaucastel is run and owned by the Perrin family, who has lived in the region for centuries and has become synonymous with Châteauneuf-du-Pape. This wine is medium bodied with well-integrated tannins, fresh acidity, and deep notes of black fruit, cocoa, tobacco, and clove. The Perrin family includes all 14 legally-sanctioned grape varieties in their blend and is the only producer of Châteauneuf-du-Pape to do so. Enjoy this wine with any of our steaks, Lamb, or the Roast Chicken entrée.

2011 Château Lalande-Borie St. Julien, Bordeaux

A relatively young Bordeaux château, Lalande-Borie is owned by the Borie family and managed by Bruno Borie, who also owns the prestigious Château Ducru-Beaucaillou. Perfumed and packed with blackberry notes, this wine displays solid structure and finishes with ripe tannins and good acidity, making it an excellent food wine.

2012 Bodegas Volver Triga Alicante, Spain

Bodegas Volver was founded in 2004 by Rafael Canizares, who is credited with the international boom in Spanish wines in the 1990s. He is an enologist and viticulturist. He is the fourth generation in his family growing and making wine. This Monastrell & Cabernet Sauvignon blend is an opaque purple. Explosive aromas of black and blue fruits are transformed into notes of licorice, Indian spices and flower oils. Rich and long, it has a good acidity that lends elegance. In the mouth, sweet blueberries and redcurrants mark the palate with persistence in a spicy, concentrated finish.

2014 Mt. Brave Cabernet Sauvignon, Mt. Veeder, Napa Valley

Among the tight-knit winegrowing community in the Napa Valley, no one understands the practical difficulties and spiritual rewards of mountain winegrowing more than Chris Carpenter. With an already legendary Napa winemaking record for Lokoya and Cardinale, Chris had little to prove when the Mt. Brave project began to evolve in 2007. And yet, the opportunity to craft wines from Mt. Veeder that would pay homage to the mountain's rich history, while expressing a new, distinguished view, proved irresistible. Blueberry, licorice, beef blood, tobacco leaf, and forest floor aromas soar from the glass of this ripe, full-bodied, opulent wine. On the palate this is a muscular, tight-knit style, with firm, dense, well-proportioned notes of dark berry, crushed rock, and graphite.

2014 Matthiasson Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley

Made from a combination of estate vineyards located in Coombsville, Rutherford, and Oak Knoll. The nose of this wine shows abundant red fruits, lots of bright cherry along with bramble-berries, such as blackberry, cranberry, mulberry, and framed with hints of mineral/herbal characters such as graphite, cedar, and pencil shavings. The palate is vibrant and fresh, with light tannin and beautiful acidity. "Matthiasson wines bear an agricultural stamp, as fresh, lively and alive as the best produce from a farmers' market" -Eric Asimov, *NY Times*
